TUITION AND FEE SCHEDULE FOR BOARDING PROGRAM

2012-2013 ACADEMIC YEAR

ADMISSION APPLICATION:

Application Fee	\$75.00
Deposit to be paid on or before the first day of school	\$2,000.00

TUITION FOR BOARDING PROGRAM: **\$15,000 00**

\$8,500.00	Tuition: Includes instruction, textbooks, and learning aids
\$6,500.00	Room and Board during the school year only, fees for activities, yearbook, labs and standardized exams. (The School will pay for one TOEFL exam and SAT or ACT)

No tuition refund can be made after the tenth day of classes.

STUDENT WORK COMMITMENT:

Presbyterian Pan American School offers to all students an integrated program designed to instill in every student the disciplines of work (punctuality, teamwork, respect for authority, thoroughness) and commitments of service (civic responsibility, servanthood, compassion), which are the foundation for Christian Leadership. Every student at Presbyterian Pan American School is required to participate at least six hours each week in meaningful work under careful staff supervision. In addition, students are encouraged to participate in planned, supervised service activities including student committees, the recycling program and the outreach program. Among the jobs performed by the students are dish washing and cooking in the kitchen, waiting on tables, checking books out at the library, landscaping and custodial work, or helping with the cattle or repairing fences at the ranch.

PAYMENT PLANS FOR TUITION:

A tuition deposit is required once a student has been accepted. This deposit, **US\$2,000.00**, which is part of the tuition, must be paid on or before the first day of school. The tuition contract will state the balance, which must be paid by the parents or guardian of the student according to one of the following payment plans:

PLAN A: Payment of the tuition balance plus any additional fees on the day of registration.

PLAN B: Payment of the tuition balance and additional fees in two installments. The first payment and additional fees must be paid on the day of registration and the second payment is due at the beginning of the second semester in January 2013.

PLAN C: Payment of the tuition balance and additional fees in eight to ten installments. The first payment and additional fees must be paid on the day of registration and the subsequent payments are due on the 15th day of each successive month through April 2013. The final payment is due by May 10, 2013.

Note: It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to require that all students be current in their tuition payments at the beginning of each eight-week grading period in order to remain registered at the school. A service charge of one and one half percent (1 ½%) is charged each month on past balances.
